Subject:- Inter Commissionerate Transfer on deputation basis as introduced through Board's letter dated 19.02.2004 –Issuance of instructions regarding its discontinuance.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Board's letter F.No. A. 22015/3/2004-Ad.III.A dated 19.02.2004 vide which Inter Commissionerate Transfers (ICT) in respect of Groups 'B' 'C' and 'D' employees were banned.

2. In this connection, it has been decided by the Board to lift the ban on ICT with immediate effect vide Board's letter F.No. A. 22015/23/2011-Ad.III.A dated 27.10.2011. Accordingly, any willing Group 'B' 'C' employee and erstwhile Group 'D' employee may apply for transfer from the jurisdiction of one Cadre Controlling Authority (CCA) to another CCA subject to availability of vacancy and on the terms & conditions mentioned in Board's letter F.No. A. 22015/23/2011-Ad.III.A dated 27.10.2011.

3. Upon the withdrawal of the ban order dated 19.02.2004 *ibid*, 'deputation on extreme compassionate ground' as introduced through the said instruction also stands withdrawn consequently.
